The following are the minimum submittal requirements for commercial remodel/tenant finish-outs. Any required item not included in the submittal will be charged additional fees. Plan reviews expire after one year from date of application.

	□ TAS (Texas Accessibility Standards)  Proof of Registration Form  Note: residential projects, multi-family projects, and commercial projects less than \$50,000 are exempted from project registration, however, all projects are subject to plan review requirements.
