**RE: Application for Participation in the Texas Events Trust Fund (2015 X Games Austin)**

Dear Deputy Comptroller:

Circuit Events Local Organizing Committee is organized as a Texas non-profit corporation (the "**Committee**") with the purpose to help facilitate and support a motor race, commonly known as "**2015 X Games Austin**" (the "**Event**") that is tentatively set to be held in Austin, Texas on June 4 - 7, 2015. Further, as an integral part of this support, the Committee and the City of Austin, as approved by City Council resolution of May 23, 2013, entered into an "**Agreement**", dated February 3, 2014, whereby the City of Austin agreed to be the "endorsing municipality" for the Event, and in the capacity of endorsing municipality (i) authorized the Committee to act as the "local organizing committee" for purposes of securing and promoting the Event for the Austin area, as well as the application for and qualification of the Event as an "**Event**" under TEX. REV. CIV. STAT. ART. 5190.14 §5.C. (the "**Act**") thereof, the Texas Events Trust Fund (the "**Trust Fund**") and (ii) authorized and appointed the Committee as the City of Austin's sole and exclusive designee, for and on behalf of the City of Austin to submit, pursuant to TAC Title 34, Part 1 Chapter 2 Subchapter B, Rule 2.202, a request to the Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts for participation in the Trust Fund program and a request to the Texas Comptroller to determine the incremental increase in the receipts of various taxes (e.g. sales and use taxes, mixed beverage taxes, hotel occupancy taxes), by the City of Austin, as the endorsing municipality, for a 30 day period that ends at the end of the day after the day of the Event (scheduled for June 4 - 7, 2015), in accordance with the Comptroller's procedures and in accordance with the Act, and the rules promulgated thereunder (the "**Rules**").

It is my honor and great pleasure to submit this application from the Committee, as the City of Austin's duly appointed and authorized designee for and on behalf of and binding upon the City of Austin, as the formal request, pursuant to Rule 2.202, for participation in the Trust Fund program and a request to the Texas Comptroller to determine the incremental increase in the applicable taxes for the City of Austin for the June 4 - 7, 2015 Event.

Further, as required by Rule 2.201(a)-(d), enclosed with this letter are: (i) Attachment 1, two (2) letters, dated July 8, 2013 and January 8, 2015, from the site selection committee for the Events, selecting the site in Austin, Texas for the 2014 – 2017 Events; (ii) Attachment 2, the economic impact study and other data with detailed information on the direct expenditures and direct impact data for the endorsing municipality hosting the event and for the requested market area (the "**Economic Study**"); (iii) Attachment 3, a description of the requested market area, and information to support the requested market area, which is



## Event Background

The **X Games** is a sports event, controlled and arranged by the U.S. sports broadcaster ESPN (with coverage also shown on its sister network ABC), which focuses on action sports. The inaugural X Games were held in summer 1995 in Rhode Island. Participants compete to win bronze, silver and gold medals, and prize money. Current competition takes place over four days with events in Moto X, Mountain Bike, Rally Car, Skateboarding and BMX.

Both the summer and winter X Games competitions feature new tricks such as Tony Hawk's 900 in skateboarding, Travis Pastrana's double backflip in freestyle motocross, Heath Frisby's first ever snowmobile front flip in Snowmobile Best Trick, and Torstein Horgmo's first landed triple flip in a snowboard competition. Concurrent with competition is the "X Fest" sports and music festival, which offers live music, athlete autograph sessions and interactive elements.

The first two summer X Games were held in Rhode Island in 1995 and 1996, averaging nearly 200,000 attendees. The 1997 and 1998 games moved to San Diego, California and were attended by more than 200,000 fans, competitors and others. The 1999 and 2000 games were held in San Francisco and were the first full professional sporting event broadcast live on the internet. The 2001 and 2002 versions moved to Philadelphia and included Taïg Khris winning the inline vert event, with the first double backflip in X Games history and Mike Metzger landing the first back flip in motocross freestyle X Games history.

X Games Nine moved to the Staples Center and LA Coliseum in Los Angeles in 2003. The venues were expanded in 2004 to include the Staples Center, Home Depot Center, and Long Beach Marine Stadium. The games have been held in Los Angeles through 2013 with several venue shifts and included numerous firsts:

- 2005: Jamie Bestwick landed the first ever double tailwhip flair in the BMX Vert Best Trick event. Travis Pastrana won gold in motocross freestyle again and became the most decorated athlete in motocross
- 2006: Travis Pastrana landed the world's first double backflip on a dirt bike, and won motocross best trick with a score of 98.60, the highest current score in best trick. Skateboarder Nyjah Huston became the youngest athlete to compete in X Games at 11 years old.

- 
- 2007: Ricky Carmichael won the first ever motocross racing circuit. Simon Tabron landed an X Games' first, doing back-to-back 900s in BMX vert.
  - 2008: Skateboarder Andy Macdonald won his 15th X Games medal, surpassing Tony Hawk as the all-time leader in skateboarding medals. Tarah Gieger of Puerto Rico won the gold medal in the first-ever women's supercross race.
  - 2009: Anthony Napolitan landed the first ever double front flip on a bicycle. Blake Williams became the first non-American rider to win FMX gold. Ashley Fiolek, 18, won the women's motocross super X, becoming the Games' first deaf medalist.
  - 2010: Jamie Bestwick became the first person to 4-peat with a win in BMX vert. Pierre-Luc Gagnon became the first athlete to win in skateboard vert three times, beating the silver medalist, Shaun White.
  - 2011: Shaun White earned his second gold medal in skateboard vert, breaking Pierre Luc Gagnon's 3-year winning streak. Liam Doran took gold on his debut in the rally car racing event after beating Marcus Gronholm in the final.
  - 2012: Bob Burnquist won his fourth Big Air gold medal, and raising his gold medal total to nine. Ronnie Renner won the gold medal in Moto X Step Up, breaking the previous record height of 37' by 10' making it the highest ever at the X Games with 47'.

In 2013 X Games expanded internationally holding events in Foz do Iguacu, Brazil, Barcelona, Spain and Munich, Germany. The 2013 event in Los Angeles saw Vicki Golden win her 3rd consecutive gold medal in women's moto x racing, defeating Meghan Rutledge. Golden also became the 1st women to compete in a freestyle moto x competition, earning bronze in best whip.

After more than a decade being hosted in Los Angeles, it was announced in August 2013 that Austin's Circuit of the Americas complex would be the venue for all future X Games excitement at least until 2017.<sup>1</sup>

X Games' organizers at ESPN announced that Texas' state capital had been selected to replace Los Angeles as its new North American home. Initially it was announced the event would be held May 15-18, but the date was later moved to June 5 - 8. Austin was picked for the X Games in an Olympic-style selection process. Of 13 qualified bids, the decision came down to Austin, Chicago, Detroit and Charlotte, N.C.

In June 2014, downtown Austin hosted the first day of X Games competition with the State Capital as the backdrop. Austin's new sports and entertainment venue---Circuit of the Americas

(COTA)--- then hosted the final three days of the X Games' competitions as well as concerts and festival villages that supplemented the sports event.

## 2014 Summer X Games Attendance

Moving a major sporting event such as X Games to a new venue half-way across the country from its previous site always results in major attendance changes. The experience at the 2014 X Games is no exception.

According to officials with ESPN and Circuit of the Americas, the inaugural X Games Austin event drew more than 160,000 over the four days from June 5 to 8. That made X Games Austin the highest non-Formula 1 attended sports and entertainment event at COTA since the venue's grand opening in 2012.<sup>2</sup>

This total four-day attendance figure is composed of a number of distinct groups present at the event based on ESPN and COTA estimates<sup>3</sup>:

Based on estimates from ESPN and from a fan survey with more than 4,000 responses, it is estimated that a total of 16,141 persons from outside Texas were in Austin for the X Games on

---

June 7, 2014. This means that 29 percent of 56,027 people in Austin for the X Games that day were from outside Texas.<sup>4</sup>

For 2015, the event will be held from June 4 to 7. Assuming no attendance change from 2014 and including the attendance during the preparation for the event and post-event tear down, the likely attendance at the 2015 X Games Austin should closely approximate the pattern in Table 2.

In particular, Table 2 estimates that 19.9 percent of all ticketed fans at the peak attendance came from outside Texas. This figure is derived from an internet fan survey of slightly more than 4,000 event attendees which indicated that 85 percent of the survey respondents were from Texas with 15 percent being from outside Texas. But, twelve percent of all respondents indicated that while they themselves were from Texas, they attended X Games Austin accompanied by one or more fans from outside of Texas. Including those fans from outside of Texas who accompanied a fan from Texas to the event indicates that just short of twenty percent of all fans in attendance at the event were from outside Texas. Finally, Table 2 adjusts the at-event attendance by out-of-state visitors to reflect the tendency for out-of-state fans to attend other attractions in Austin some days of their stay rather than attending all days of the X Games based on the survey responses as to how often out-of-state fans attended X Games events each day.

The last column of Table 2 estimates the pattern of stay by out-of-state fans at X Games in the Austin area. This pattern of stay is estimated to be consistent both with overall ticket sales and the fan survey responses indicating that out-of-state fans stayed, on average, 3.11 nights in Austin for the event.

### Event Presentation Costs and Ticket Sales

From 2010 to 2013, X Games event presentation costs averaged \$16.9 million in California. But for Austin, it was expected that these costs would amount to about \$19 million with about \$10 million spent directly in Texas.<sup>5</sup> Table 3 presents some detail about these expenditures in Texas including the amount subject to state sales tax.<sup>6</sup>

Ticket revenues for 2014 averaged \$45 a day per ticket.<sup>7</sup> Based on the sales from 2014, total ticket revenue from out-of-state fans reached approximately \$1.04 million generating nearly \$65,000 in state sales taxes from tickets sold to out-of-state fans.

## Direct Economic Gains from 2015 X Games

As just discussed, the economic gains from events such as the 2014 X Games Austin are significant for the state and for the local economy. Under a conservative assumption that the activity at the 2015 X Games Austin will only meet the level of fan and other visitor activity seen in 2014, the 2015 Austin X Games are expected to fill an estimated 33,500 hotel room nights and generate an estimated total direct spending by ESPN personnel, athletes, managers, sponsors, guests, media and fans of nearly \$31.3 million.<sup>8</sup> This gain is composed of \$8.0 million in lodging expenditures, \$7.5 million in food and beverage expenditures and more than \$4.9 million in entertainment and shopping expenditures.

In calculating these gains a number of event-specific data points are used. These include the hotel room costs based on what ESPN paid each day for their employees at the games.<sup>9</sup> In addition, the 2014 fan survey from the X Games event indicated 79 percent of out-of-state fans for the event stayed in hotels.

Also used in establishing expenditure patterns for X Games were the spending patterns derived from the fan survey indicating that each out of state fan spent \$102.93 on food and non-alcoholic beverages each day, \$13.17 on mixed drinks each day, \$15.38 on merchandise at the event each day, \$26.37 on merchandise in Austin outside of the event each day, and \$28.01 on other entertainment each day.

## Event Trust Fund Tax Gain

In 2009 the Texas legislature established the Events Trust Fund to assist in attracting to Texas or retaining in Texas sporting and other events that could well be moved outside the state. The provisions of this law allow the Comptroller to deposit into a trust fund established for a qualifying event the amount of state hotel, sales and use, motor vehicle rental and alcohol taxes that can be attributed to the incremental gain in economic activity to the state from hosting the event. To qualify for reimbursement from the Trust Fund, the local sponsoring municipality or county must contribute matching tax revenues received from hosting the event at the rate of \$1 local tax dollar for every \$6.25 in state tax contributions.

Based on statutory tax rates and the attendance figures presented in Table 2, Table 4 projects the tax gain to the state and to the City of Austin from hosting the 2015 X Games. In 2015, this event is expected to generate a total of \$1,705,151 in state tax revenues which could be deposited into the trust fund to support this event. However, since 2015 marks the second year this event has been held in Texas, this reduces the total state contribution to \$1,457,344. The total local tax gain to the City of Austin is estimated to reach \$721,308 which greatly exceeds the maximum matching requirement for state taxes of \$233,183. Accordingly, CELOC requests the Comptroller to set-up an Event Trust Fund account for this event to contain \$1,457,344 in eligible state tax revenues when matched by local contributions by or on behalf of the City of Austin of \$233,183 for a total trust fund amount of \$1,690,577.

Specifically, in the January 2013 Biennial Revenue Estimate prepared by the Comptroller of Public Accounts, the estimated tax gain during the next biennium for the Mixed beverage tax is \$1,624 million (see page 17). The estimated gain from the other Alcoholic Beverage taxes is estimated at \$416 million or roughly a quarter of the tax raised by the state under the Mixed Beverage Tax. Accordingly, Table 5 applies the statutory tax rate of 11 percent to the value of mixed beverages as described in law and approximates the alcoholic beverage tax gains as being 2.56 percent of the value of mixed beverages which raises about a quarter of mixed tax raised by the state under the mixed beverage tax for this event. Since there is no local tax component to the alcoholic beverage tax, no estimate for this is included in Table 5.

<sup>16</sup> For fans this is the percentage of cars rented per group adjusting for the fact that some groups rented more than one car. For other groups, this is set equal to the percentage of fans that said they rented cars but assumes each group rents only one car.
