

## CLOUD PAVILION | BY BEILI LIU



Coming in mid-2020 to the Seaholm EcoDistrict, *Cloud Pavilion*, by local artist Beili Liu, is inspired by the progression of evaporation, condensation and precipitation. The sculpture will be located at the Austin Energy District Cooling Plant #3. This district cooling system provides an efficient and environmentally-friendly way to cool multiple buildings. District cooling systems are common in major cities in this country and throughout the world, particularly in cities that boast a dense urban core.

*Cloud Pavilion* will be a 15' x 20' x 10-14' high group of mirror-finish floating rings, reminiscent of clouds, supported by an organic structure of angled columns which allude to the rise and fall of water during the hydrological cycle.
