

Did you know...

- The City of Austin has home repair and financial empowerment programs?
 - The City of Austin has several Homeowners and Renters Assistance programs to help low-income households in the Austin city limits.
 - Programs are FREE or offer 0% interest rates to eligible residents.

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Home Repair Eligibility

- General Requirements:
 - 80% Median Family Income
 - Live within the Austin city limits
- Program Specific Requirements:
 - ► ABR
 - Applicant or household member are at least age 62 OR severely disabled (as defined by federal regulations)
 - PLP
 - 100% MFI
 - Received a violation notice from Austin Water Utility about a defect in the Private Lateral
 Pipeline
 - Property is principle residence and is a single-family home or duplex
 - ► HRLP
 - Clear property title and ownership interest solely in applicants' name(s)
 - Single-family detached home

Architectural Barrier Removal (ABR)

- Up to \$15,000 grant to modify the homes of elderly (62 or older) and/or severely disabled homeowners and renters to increase self-sufficiency, mobility, and safety
 - Handrails
 - Door widening
 - Buzzing or flashing devices (for persons with impaired hearing or vision)
 - Accessible door handles or faucet handles
 - Shower grab bars
 - Shower wands
 - Elevated toilets
 - Accessible sinks and showers
- Available for renters and homeowners








Private Lateral Pipeline Grant (PLP)

Repair or replacement of Private Lateral pipelines

▶ PLP is the portion of the wastewater service line located on property that connects the building structure to the City wastewater main line located in the street right-of-way or Utility easement.






Home Rehabilitation Loan Program (HRLP)

- To help homeowners bring their homes up to building code standards making homes safe and sanitary
- Qualified repairs:
 - Foundation, roof, plumbing, HVAC system, electrical work and other major interior and exterior repairs
- Both reconstruction and rehabilitation are offered depending on condition of home

Home Rehabilitation Loan Program (HRLP)

- ▶ HRLP Rehabilitation
 - 0% interest, 15 year deferred forgivable loan
 - Assistance \$15,000-\$75,000
- ▶ HRLP Reconstruction
 - \$130,000 average cost
 - 20 year affordability period
 - 25% shared equity, 30 year loan term
 - 0% interest, deferred forgivable loan








GO Repair Program

- Up to \$15,000 of assistance per home to address substandard housing conditions
- Eligible Repairs
 - Accessible handrails, ramps, cabinets
 - Electrical, plumbing, mechanical repairs
 - Drywall, flooring, exterior siding repair
 - Ceiling fans, roof patches, roof replacements
 - Structural carpentry/integrity: support beams, rotten floor joists (usually result of leak), rotten wall members, shower wands
 - Appliances (refrigerator and/or stove)
 - Life safety requirements according to the applicable building code




