
## Imagine Austin: Background










# **PAZ-Identified Projects**

Great Streets Program	Funding for implementation of Great Streets Improvements to several downtown streets as part of the overall Great Streets Master Plan:	\$64,000,000
Cesar Chavez Promenade (San Antonio – Lamar)	Construction of promenade extension West of San Antonio.	7,000,000
Congress Avenue Streetscape (11 <sup>th</sup> – Riverside)	Streetscape improvements to Congress Avenue supporting Congress Avenue Urban Design Initiative (underway).	22,000,000
4 <sup>th</sup> Street (IH 35 – Rio Grande)	Design and Construction of Great Streets improvements on 4 <sup>th</sup> Street.	12,000,000
5 <sup>th</sup> Street ( IH 35 – Lamar)	Design and construction of Great Streets Improvements on 5 <sup>th</sup> Street.	14,000,000
6 <sup>th</sup> Street (Congress – Lamar)	Design and construction of Great Streets Improvements on 6 <sup>th</sup> Street.	9,000,000
Williamson Creek Urban Trail (Design)	Design of Williamson Creek Urban Trail between West Gate and S. 1st (Catalyst for South Austin Combined Plan)	\$500,000
