The division is responsible for end-to-end procurement and contracting activities, including solicitation, preparing Recommendations for Council Action (RCAs), contract development and execution, resolution of contractor and consultant issues, and providing contract management oversight. The team is a key member of the City's project team and engages regularly with various stakeholders, including business partners, trade associations, and the consulting and contracting communities.

POSITION OVERVIEW

The Procurement Specialist IV will be responsible for end-to-end procurement of construction and construction-related professional services. The position will provide guidance to business partners on procurement processes; lead procurement and contracting activities; resolve contract disputes, and represent the department at various meetings, outreach events, and educational opportunities with City management, internal and external stakeholders. The ideal candidate will have demonstrated success as a leader, experience utilizing alternative delivery methodologies, strong negotiation and facilitation skills, the ability to manage complex contractual issues, and will possess strong communication skills.

MINIMUM & PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS:

Qualified candidates must have a Bachelor's degree in from an accredited college or university, plus five (5) years of experience in a related field. A graduate degree from and accredited college or university in a related field may substitute up to two (2) years of the required experience.

The ideal candidate will have experience procuring, developing, negotiating, and administering contracts for capital improvement projects or other complex construction projects.

COMPENSATION AND BENEFITS

Salary is based on qualifications and experience. In addition, the City offers an excellent comprehensive benefits package including:

Retirement – Defined Benefit Pension Plan with vesting after 5 years of continuous service.

Health – Three plans from which to choose (BlueCross Blue Shield PPO, BlueCross Blue Shield HMO, BlueCross Blue Shield Consumer Driven Health Plan with Health Savings Account). Employee only coverage is paid by the City; dependent coverage is available at a subsidized rate.

Dental – Employee only coverage. Dependent coverage is available at a subsidized rate.

Vacation – Accrual based on tenure (up to 7.67 hrs. per pay period) for 24 of the 26 pay periods; Payment of unused personal leave upon resignation or retirement is limited to 240 hours.

Sick Leave – Accrue 1 day per month; unlimited accrual
