## Austin-Bergstrom International Airport (AUS):

City of Austin opened Austin-Bergstrom International Airport (ABIA) in 1999, after converting the former Bergstrom Air Force Base. Massive new construction was undertaken including the modern 700,000 square feet passenger terminal named after Barbara Jordan “Texas Civil Rights Activist” and a new air-control tower. With over 4,200 acres owned by the City of Austin, two (2) wide spaced parallel runways allowing simultaneous landings and/or takeoffs. Twenty-four (24) aircraft gates and one (1) commuter gate and currently constructing a nine (9) gates expansion schedule OPENING 2019, with the soon to open South Terminal in April 2017. ABIA serviced over 11 million passengers in 2016 to 52 non-stop destinations, with 13 major Air-carriers. The campus has a Hilton hotel (273 guest rooms) with an additional Hyatt Place hotel (139 guest rooms). Over \$280 million dollars in Capital Improvement are scheduled for multiple parking lot projects, a new Department of Aviation professional buildings and upgrades to make our traveling customers feel that unique “Austin, Texas Hospitality”.



The Occupational Environmental Health & Safety Manager will report to the Aviation Chief Operations Officer. To be considered for this position graduation from an accredited four (4) year college or university with major coursework in a field related to Industrial Hygiene, Safety, any physical or life sciences or related field , plus six (6) years of related experience including at least two (2) years in a lead/supervisory capacity. A Master's degree in Industrial Hygiene, Safety or a related field may substitute for up to two (2) years of experience. A valid Texas Driver's License is also required.
