The mobile van team is composed of neighborhood liaisons, nurses and community workers, who provide mobile health services. The mission of the mobile health van program is to increase health screenings in minority neighborhoods. The vans will seek to overcome obstacles, such as inconvenience and expense, that prevent people from being tested.



The vans will be scheduled for services at community grocery stores, churches, apartments and other community locations.

All services of the vans will be free of charge.
