





Figure 3. Travis County Reported Cases of Salmonella by Year 1990 – 2012^{1,2}

The number of Salmonella cases varies over time in Travis County (Figure 1 and Figure 3). The total number of annual Salmonella reports has been increasing each year since 2008 (Figure 3). Early 2012 data is available and seems to suggest that there might be a decline in the number of Salmonella cases (Figure 2). However, data is not complete for and preliminary results should be interpreted with caution. The true impact of Salmonella on the community will be determined from finalized data.

Figure 2. Travis County Reported Cases of Salmonella by Month of Report 2008 - 2012^{1,3}


