



Compact and Connected Priority Program Implementation Team 2017 Work Plan (DRAFT January 2017)

Mission

- Convene – Provide a forum for discussions and decision-making for cross-departmental issues and programs that fall under Imagine Austin’s “compact and connected” vision through monthly meetings of the Compact and Connected Priority Program Implementation Team.
- Connect – Bring City staff together for informal gatherings themed around various C&C issues and introduce staff across departments working on related projects and issues, through quarterly brown bag presentations and other events.
- Inform – Provide ongoing education and guidance to COA Departments, Projects, Teams, and Capital Planning on incorporating C+C goals and optimizing C+C outcomes through Imagine Austin News, Imagine Austin Annual Report, Compact and Connected Training, and other methods. Provide public information and education through “Spotlights” and other methods.
- Create – Develop recommendations and coordinate cross-departmental initiatives that support investment in Compact and Connected.

2017 Goals

- Spotlights: Recognize private sector investment in C+C through Spotlights initiative.
- Compact & Connected Training – Oversee further development of the C+C Training program, to include a spring and fall version of the course and explore development of a Community version. Coordinate a regular brown-bag presentation for graduates.
- Assess Progress – Assess City progress toward implementing Priority Program 1 Compact and Connected through *Imagine Austin* annual report as well as a more detailed technical progress report.
- CodeNEXT – Continue to provide guidance and input to the CodeNEXT process, to ensure IA C+C policies are fully reflected in code rewrite.
- Mobility – Provide consultation support to Corridor Program Implementation Office and Austin Transportation Department during development of Austin Strategic Mobility Plan and implementation of 2016 Mobility Bond.
