I understand that the deferral period is **90 days** from the date this form is postmarked and agree to the terms of the Deferred Disposition, which are:

1. The payment must be made equal to the current balance less \$30 of the case which is \$ _____

2. Complete a Boat Safety Class and submit a copy of the certification of completion by the end of the deferral period which is **90 days** from the date this request is postmarked. The copy may be submitted in person, by fax, by mail or via email; **and**
3. Notify the Court in writing of any change of name or address; **and**
4. Commit no boating violations within the city limits of the City of Austin, Texas during the deferral period.
