Complete either the three (3) hour online Defensive Cycling course through the Center for Cycling Education (register at <u>www.thecce.org/dc-austin</u>) OR a six (6) hour Driving Safety Course approved by the Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation and submit to the Court the original "Court" copy of the certification of completion (for the online course, the certification is emailed directly to the Court following successful completion of the course) by the end of the deferral period which is 90 days from the date this request is postmarked; and
- 3. If second or subsequent deferred disposition, commit no moving traffic violation within the city limits of the City of Austin, Texas.
