AARC Young Actors Studio Theater Art Camps for Kids

Learn and develop acting and theater production skills, as well as unique art and craft making, while also exploring Asian American history and multiculturalism in these engaging, hands-on camps. Half of each day will be devoted to theater arts, while the other half of the day will focus on arts and crafts. At the end of the two-week session, parents are invited to enjoy the final student-produced play. Students will not only have fun, but also gain knowledge about cultural identities and develop new tools for artistic expression.

Summer Sessions

All sessions run for two weeks, Monday through Friday, 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. **Tuition: \$270 per session for City of Austin Residents; \$300 per session for Non-Residents.** Please send your child with a healthy snack and lunch that does not require refrigeration.

Session 1, ages 5-10: June 15 - June 26

Session 2, ages 11-16: June 29 - July 10

Session 3, ages 5-10: July 13 - July 24

Session 4, ages 11-16: July 27 - August 7

Early Bird & Late Bird Camp:

\$50 per session for early drop off from 7:45 to 8:45 a.m.

\$50 per session for late pick up from 5:00 to 6:00 p.m.

1. Walk-in registration and online registration begins on **3/7/15 at 10 a.m.**
 2. Pay \$35 non-refundable deposit per child to secure your spot.
 3. Tuition balance due two weeks before designated camp start date.
