Teen adoptees from Asia will engage in leadership and identity building activities in this new camp. The first week of camp includes learning Asian American history and culture from special guests and community partners of the AARC. The second week is focused on supporting and collaborating with camp instructors for the Asian Adoptees Youth Camp. Teens will have an opportunity to lead groups in cultural activities and exercises for youth ages 5-10.
