**About the Project:**

Anticipated in 2016, the City of Austin will begin work on the Dove Springs District Park Recreation Center Expansion project. Currently, the 18,000 sq. ft. center has a full court gymnasium, weight room, arts and crafts room/computer lab, class room, dance studio, conference room, lobby and television room. With funding allocated from the 2012 GO Bond, the Department is looking to add more flexible spaces to meet the desires for new and expanded programming.
