



Bartholomew Municipal Pool at Bartholomew District Park



The Bartholomew Pool construction began in September, 2012. During the demolition phase of the project, Chasco, the project contractor, encountered numerous asbestos pipes encircling the facility. Remediation of the asbestos piping occurred without difficulty but challenged the construction schedule. Further, upon removal of the remaining structure, ground water has been detected. Austin Water Utility along with staff from Watershed Protection analyzed and determined the ground water may be coming from a City water line and a natural source. A great deal of ground water is entering the construction site and the project needs additional engineering to investigate the problems and develop solutions. Engineering will include the design of a French drain to surround the facility and the preparation of specifications for constructing structural piers to prevent shifting of the pool and bathhouse structures. These issues add additional time to the construction and thus will delay the opening. You may view the project fact sheet at this web site link


