



Bartholomew Municipal Pool at Bartholomew District Park



A neighborhood meeting was held at University Hills Library on February 6, 2013 to inform the community of the construction status of Bartholomew Pool. The community was informed of the construction delays that were encountered. One delay included the removal of buried pool pipes and asbestos insulation. These were found after the pool shell had been removed. In addition, while prepping the site for the new pool, the contractor encountered ground water seeping up through the ground and filling the area where the new pool was to be built. Work once again stopped until the source of that water could be determined. Due to the presence of ground water, the construction methods planned will need to be revised so that the life span of the facility is not adversely affected.

The previously mentioned meeting was well attended and the neighborhood was able to express their interest in several improvements, such as increasing the depth of the lap pool, diving opportunities and additional shade. **The next community input meeting will be held on March 6, 2013 at Blanton Elementary School from 6:30 to 7:30pm.** We urge the community to attend this meeting so that the changes proposed can be shared and discussed. Also, PARD is planning an additional meeting that will summarize the changes and schedule for the design and construction of Bartholomew Pool.


