

Pickfair Recreation Center Improvements



The Austin Parks and Recreation Department is conducting a public information and input process on the proposed American with Disability Act (ADA) improvements to the Pickfair Recreation Center including several playground improvements.

The first of two meetings was held on January 20, 2011. The purpose of the first meeting was to provide information on the ADA improvements proposed to the existing Pickfair Recreation Center. The first meeting engaged the community and invited feedback on the proposed improvements to the parkland.

Project Synopsis to date:

Jackson Galloway and Associates presented preliminary plans on the proposed ADA improvements to the Pickfair Recreation Center. The proposed improvements include widening the main entry into the facility, design of an accessible parking spot, accessible path to the main entry of the building and major renovation of the existing restrooms to meet current ADA requirements. In addition, the design consultant illustrated several landscape improvements to the parkland including a new play structure.
