





# Daugherty Arts Center

- Convenient location with lake frontage
- Flat site, outside the floodplain, good visibility
- Will impact Pitch and Putt




Location A

- Moves frontage away from Barton Springs Road
- Flat site, but in the floodplain
- Contained area accommodates DAC program
- Near the heart of downtown
- Will impact Pitch and Putt




**Location B**

- Flat parkland area outside the floodplain
- In the heart of the park
- Needs additional parking
- Location in park could be problematic for usage
- Entry and exit control needed
- Occupies large park area without adding activity



**Location C**

- Location stays the same
- Must be lifted above the floodplain
- Needs additional parking
- Needs remediation of toxic soils
- Structural cost will increase total project cost

# Alliance Children's Garden

## 2002 Schematic

- Symmetrical layout based on the Golden Mean
- Processional walk with individual artworks that relate to children
- More of a true art garden than an interactive play area
- Strong horizontal lines in the layout
- Shade structures provided
- Ponds with water and programmed jets in raised basins
- Detailed paving pattern designs in flatwork
- Layout: a self-contained experience
- Approximate \$4 million



Alliance Children's Garden - 2002

## 2009 Schematic

- One quarter of the site is non-programmed lawn
- One quarter is a memorial hill dedicated to the founders
- Asymmetrical layout, Golden Mean
- Children's interactive water program in one quarter
- Celestial shade structures
- One quarter nature play
- Pathway to the Liz Carpenter Fountain
- Approximate \$2 million







Riverside Road Diagram – with modified road




Schematic Design – with modified road


