ABSTRACT ACRYLIC PAINT

Acrylic paints (note: if you are wanting to use student grade paints, I recommend the Matisse brand at Jerry's. If you want to upgrade to another brand, Golden makes luscious colors). **This is the basic list of Acrylic paint:**

- Titanium white
- Cadmium yellow hue or hansa yellow medium
- Yellow ochre or yellow oxide
- Cadmium red medium or equivalent
- Cadmium orange or equivalent
- Ultramarine blue
- Burnt Umber
- Burnt Sienna
- Permanent green or permanent green light
- Pthalo blue
- Manganese Blue Hue (in the Matisse brand it is called Primary Blue)
- Magenta (Violet)
- Cerulean blue

Optional colors:

- Pthalo green
- N3 Neutral Gray
- Raw Umber
- Iridescent Pearl
- Silver
- Magenta Light
- Cobalt Teal (turquoise)
- Cobalt Titanate Green
- Plus any other colors you just love

Paint mediums:

- Fluid (or liquid) medium
- Golden paint mediums: heavy gel or extra heavy gel, clear tar gel, high solid gel
- Choose one (or more) from the following: coarse pumice gel, glass bead gel, crackle paste, garnet gel

Paint brushes

- Round and flat brushes in various sizes (I recommend buying at least one expensive brush for details, then a mid sized round and mid sized flat).
- Inexpensive brushes....I highly recommend the Master's Touch Flat Brush Set for \$4.99 for broader strokes. They look like this: <http://shop.hobbylobby.com/products/masters-touch-flat-brush-set-224451/>
- Latex gloves and plastic container for water (i.e. big cup or large reusable yogurt container)
- Palette (you can buy one, or just use waxed paper on a flat surface, or re-use plastic containers. The bigger the better. Another inexpensive option is a plastic plate.
- Color wheel (print from the internet http://northcountrypublicradio.org/blogs/artthrob/uploaded_images/simple-color-wheel-784019.gif or buy hard copy at art store)
- Sketch Pad (at least 5X7)
- Watercolor Paper (at least 10 sheets, 8X10 or larger)
- Pencil
- 4 canvases, 1-2.5 inches deep (can be any size ranging from 10X10-24X30 (you can go bigger if you like, but just be prepared to work on it quite a bit outside of class)

Optional Supplies:

- water sprayer (some will be provided)
- Journal to brainstorm ideas and take notes in, favorite books/magazines on painting and artists

Refunds are issued to the charging credit card, by check from the City of Austin (please allow 4 - 6 weeks for processing) or you may apply the credit to your account; which may be used by any immediate family member for any program offered at the Dougherty Arts School for up to one year. Please note that refunds under \$10 will only be made to the charging credit card or to credit your account. We are sorry that we are unable to process refund checks under \$10 at this time. There is a \$25 cash fee on all returned checks.
