INTERPRETIVE PORTRAIT

1. Six photographs of people you would like to interpret plus one of you.
2. Close up to see features and we can create and expand from that point.

Journal/Sketch Book

- I suggest you look for a **hard cover** spiral bound book. The reason I suggest spiral is so the book lies flat when you open it. It's easier to draw in. Suggested sizes and this depends on what you're comfortable with:
- 10 x 7 ½ inches
- 7 x 10 inches
- 10 x 10 inches
- 9 x 12 inches

Canvas Panel

- Fredrix is inexpensive and usually comes in a double pack or three pack. However if you can't find that brand just get the least expensive.
- 11 x 14 inches

Art Pads

Some of these are specifically pastel or watercolor books. The watercolor and pastel will have very heavy weight, grainy textured paper. A smooth surface will work better with soft pastels and oil pastels. Any size you feel comfortable working with

Writing Instruments

- Prismacolor black pens. They come in a package of five (or 6) in different point sizes.
- Sharpies won't work because they will BLEED through the paper.

Pencils

Charcoal pencils...I recommend the package with the eraser, white pencil, two charcoals.

MORE Stuff

- Water color set and brush, Water color pencils are cool to work with as well!
- Oil pastels...go for the cheapest but aim for a set of 24 or more. I will give you more colors to play with.
- Soft Pastels. Set of 24 or more.
- Six pack of BASIC acrylic paints.
- Paint brushes for acrylic paints
- Small plastic mixing trays. (usually a dollar or two)
- Fixative Fijador (Spray Can) for Pastel, Charcoal and pencil. Any brand will do but basically this sets the medium so it doesn't smear or flake off over time.
- These are just to get started. If there is anything you are drawn to at the store, by all means, bring it in and let's play! Don't go by the brand names. Find what attracts you and what you can afford.
