

Frequently Asked Questions:

Q. Where can I get a golf lesson?

A. Lessons are available at each of our facilities so choose a location which is convenient for you.

Q. Who teaches the lessons?

A. We have PGA trained staff members at each facility as well as independent contractors who offer individual and group instruction.

Q. When are lessons conducted?

A. Individual lessons are arranged with each instructor based on your schedules.

Q. What if I do not have golf clubs yet?

A. No problem. Let the instructor know ahead of time so arrangements can be made to use clubs which are available at no charge at each facility.

Q. Do I need golf shoes?

A. No, a comfortable pair of athletic shoes will work fine. Shoes with large cleats or metal spikes are not allowed however.

Q. Can I bring a friend or spouse to take the lesson with me?

A. Absolutely, just make arrangements with the instructor prior to arrival.

Q. What do lessons cost?

A. The rate for lessons varies by each instructor and are usually 30, 45 or 60 minutes in length.

Q. Are group golf clinics offered?

A. Yes, visit our website often for updated clinic information. Clinics will be posted to the website every month.

Q. We have about 20 individuals at my company interested in golf lessons. Can we arrange a large group golf clinic?

A. Yes, and for a group of this size, two or three instructors would conduct the clinic.

Q. Is on-course instruction available?

A. Yes, playing lessons are available preferably at non-busy times on each course.

Q. What is the dress code for golf lessons?

A. Wear comfortable clothes, and don't forget a hat, cap or sunscreen.
