PERMIT CONDITIONS:

These conditions apply only if the Director approves the permit request.

Applicant agrees to comply with, and shall require its contractors, agents, invitees, guests, volunteers, and patrons of the Event for which the Applicant plans to use the permit to comply with all federal, state and local laws and regulations, and with all applicable City policies, rules and procedures.

Applicant shall not bring or permit its contractors, agents, invitees, guests, volunteers, and patrons of the Event for which the Applicant plans to use the Facility and/ or Park to bring or keep anything on City property that may adversely affect the Facility and / or City Parklands.

Applicant understands and agrees that a slackline must only be affixed on a temporary basis and must be removed once the slackline is no longer in use.

Applicant agrees to ensure that slacklining equipment is maintained in an operable and safe condition. Applicant agrees to remove equipment determined to be unsafe by a park employee.

a tree that is less than 1 foot in diameter, the tree is a heritage tree, or the tree has been identified as a not for use for slacklining. Applicant agrees not to alter or damage a tree. Applicant must ensure that a piece of fabric, at least one-quarter in thick, is placed between the tree and the slackline.

Applicant agrees to only set up a slackline in a location where a clear and flat landing surface is present under the full length of the slackline. Applicant agrees that a slackline may not be set up six feet above the natural grade at the center of the span, within 25 feet of a sidewalk, building, road, street, bikeway, water feature, sport court, bike rack, handrail, art object, fence, or light pole as measured from the center of the span or without the written permission of the director of special events if the span exceeds 100 feet. Applicant agrees to not set up a slackline in a manner that blocks a park entrance or exit, or interrupts the existing use of an area by the general public.

Indemnification. Applicant shall indemnify, save, and hold harmless the City, its officers, employees, agents, licensees, and invitees ("**Indemnitees**") against any and all liability, damages, losses, claims, demands, and actions of any nature, due to personal injury (including, without limitation, workers' compensation and death claims), or property loss or damage of any kind ("**Claims**") which arises or is claimed to arise out of or is in any manner connected with the use of the City property or the presence on the City property of the Applicant, its contractors, agents, invitees, guests, volunteers, and patrons of the Event for which the Applicant plans to use the Facility, except as to Claims which arise out or are related to City's negligence or intentional acts or omissions. The undersigned warrants that he/she has the authority to bind the Applicant to this indemnification provision. Applicant agrees to be liable and responsible for all activity on the Applicant's slackline.

The Park Ranger Program Manager may revoke a permit if Applicant commits three violations of the Slacklining Rules Defined under Section 14.1.15 of the City of Austin's Building Criteria Manual. An Applicant whose permit has been revoked may not reapply for one year. An Applicant who has had two permits is ineligible for a new permit. Additionally, Applicant or Applicant's contractors, agents, invitees, guests, volunteers, and patrons may be removed from the park for an individual violation.
