Please consider obtaining some of the adjacent flood prone properties. The lower south Imperial Valley neighborhood which is adjacent to the proposed park has little developmental value as the lots have no utilities, limited access, and are 10-20' below the FEMA 100 year floodplain elevation. These empty lots attract encampments of people in makeshift shelters that are a health hazard due to the lack of water and sanitation as well as a crime attractant. The high risk of flooding in addition to the limited access also makes the area a danger to the people encamped there. Travis County Sheriff deputies and environmental officers have a long history of responding to issues there, but because of minimal cooperation from the landowners they have had little success in resolving the inherent issues. This would not make for a good neighbor to a newly established park and would likely depress attendance as well as leave visitors concerned for their safety. With the Walter E Long Park so close, don't overdo the activities at this park. This should be lower intensity uses than at WELong Park.




## Q29 8. How many individuals live in your household?
