Registration

Registration for Camp Gonnahavefun begins **Saturday, March 3 at 9:00 a.m.** and ends at 12 p.m. (or until all spaces are filled). During registration, an individual may register his/her family plus the children from one other family.

Space in ALL age groups for each session is limited! Once a session becomes full, participants may be added to a wait list.

Parents/Guardians may enroll their child/children in camp by paying a \$20 deposit for each week they want their child/children to attend camp. The remaining balance is then due 2 weeks prior to the program start date. If the balance is not received by 6:00 p.m. on the due date, the child's space and the \$20 deposit* will automatically be forfeited and customers on the waiting list will be contacted.

*Deposits are non-refundable, but may be transferred to your account if the request is made in writing by 6:00 p.m. on Friday, May 11, 2012. Deposits cannot be transferred after May 11. The program fee is refunded in full only if the class is canceled by the Austin Parks and Recreation Department.

Hancock accepts cash, check, or money order. If you are paying by cash, please have exact change!
