Hours of Operation

Public Tennis Center Court Fees

Non-Prime Time - Fees are for 1 ½ hour for singles and 2 hours for doubles

Adults - \$2.75 per person

Juniors - \$1.50 per person (18 & under)

Seniors - \$2.50 per person (62 & over)

Prime Time - Fees are for 1 ½ hour for singles and 2 hours for doubles

\$4.00 per person - No distinction of age.

An Alternate fee may be used when normal time frames cannot be reserved, such as 1 hour from 9 to 10 p.m. or a half hour gap between reservations.
