211.2 DETERMINING THE CORRECT FORCE LEVEL

211.2.1 LEVEL 1 FORCE INCIDENTS AND IN-CUSTODY DEATHS

- (a) Any force resulting in death.
- (b) Any force that resulted in a substantial risk of death.
- (c) Any intentional firearm discharge at a person, vehicle, or structure regardless of injury.
 - 1. For the purposes of this General Order, TASER Conducted Energy Weapons and less lethal weapons firing kinetic energy projectiles (i.e., less lethal shotguns, 37mm, and 40mm launchers) are not considered firearms.
