803 Duty Firearms

803.1 PURPOSE AND SCOPE

This order sets guidelines on the types of authorized weapons and ammunition, as well as procedures for registration, qualification, and proficiency with authorized duty weapons. For purposes of this order, on-duty is defined as any activity in which the employee is receiving compensation or benefit as a result of receives compensation or benefit from their employment with the Department, or wearing any part of the uniform. For the purposes of this General Order, TASER Conducted Energy Weapons are not considered firearms.
