# **304 LIVESTREAMING**

## 304.1 PURPOSE AND SCOPE

### 304.1.2 OFFICERS

The department recognizes that officers on scene may find it beneficial to utilize the 'View Location' function when setting a perimeter, conducting an open field search, or other incidents in which officers may be away from their patrol cars. However, the ability to livestream Axon® devices is reserved for supervisors with direct command and control over an incident or call for service and the employees who are actively working on the incident or call for service. Officers have 'View Location' privileges and cannot live stream.

### 304.1.2 304.1.3 COMMUNICATIONS

The Department recognizes that the Communications Team plays a vital role in the safety of the public, officer safety, and the overall resolution of incidents or calls for service. However, the ability to livestream Axon® devices is reserved for those supervisors that have with direct command and control over an incident or call for service and the employees who are actively working on the incident or call for service.

Dispatchers and communication supervisors have 'View Location' privileges and cannot livestream.
