
To Stakeholder, Property Owner, or Resident:

In order to improve safety for all modes of transportation, the City's Public Works Department is implementing and improving a bicycle route system, as directed by the Austin City Council per **City Ordinance No. 20090611-075 (The Austin Bicycle Plan)**. Guadalupe Street from St Johns Avenue to Morrow Street is part of Route 47 of the City of Austin bicycle system. You are receiving this notification because you live on and/or own property adjacent to Guadalupe Street in Austin, Texas, and/or are a stakeholder in the area.

In coordination with routine street maintenance (road re-surfacing and re-striping), and to enhance mobility in the corridor for both motor vehicles and bicycles, the street striping will be reconfigured to modify parking and improve existing bicycle lanes. To accomplish this reconfiguration, on-street motor vehicle parking will be prohibited on certain sections of Guadalupe Street. The corridor's safety and mobility, as well as the results of an on-street parking use analysis, were considered to determine these parking modifications:


- **Guadalupe Street** (from St Johns Avenue to Bissonet Lane) – prohibit parking on the east and west sides of the street.
- **Guadalupe Street** (from Bissonet Lane to Morrow Street) – prohibit parking on the east side of the street.

As indicated in Figure 1, Guadalupe Street (from Bissonet Lane to Morrow Street) will have permitted parking on only one side of the street. Guadalupe Street will still have bicycle lanes in both directions and will also have a parking lane on the west side of the street as shown below in Figure 2.
