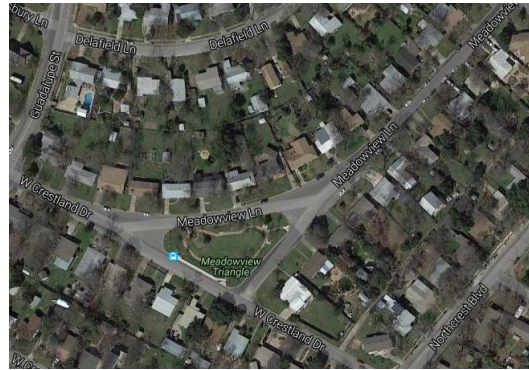
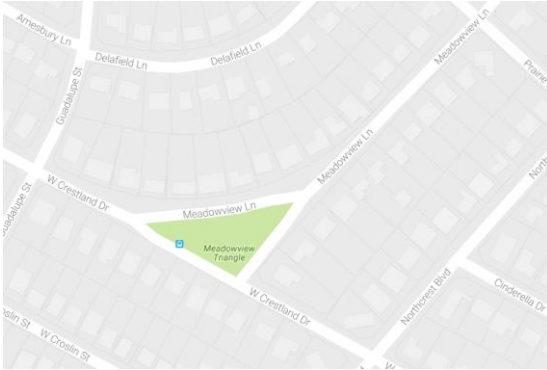


# Neighborhood Partnering Program Application Summary

## Project Scope & Description

- The project will create a pocket park and install landscaping, benches and a large bird house.
- Project concept has been reviewed and approved by staff at Public Works and Parks and Recreation Departments.
