



# Neighborhood Partnering Program Application Summary

**Project Name:** S. 5<sup>th</sup> Street – Barton Skyway Sidewalk

Project location: S. 5<sup>th</sup> Street, Barton Skyway



## Project Scope & Description

- Project is to install a sidewalk on the west side of South 5<sup>th</sup> Street from approximately 2880 S. 5<sup>th</sup> Street where the existing sidewalk ends to Barton Skyway, turning the corner onto the north side of Barton Skyway and continuing to the intersection of Barton Skyway with Garden Villa Lane. A small gap of sidewalk on the east side of S. 5<sup>th</sup> Street, ADA compliant curb ramps and bulb outs will also be provided as part of this project. Requested painted crosswalks are also requested for this project.
- Sidewalk has been vetted through Public Works' Sidewalk Program and Austin Transportation Traffic Engineering


