


Funded by the 2016

- 5,876 feet of trail (1.1 miles)

#### Oltorf to Burleson



- Existing section of Country Club Creek Trail
- Trail opened in 2014
- 3,470 feet of trail (0.66 miles)

#### Burleson to Ventura



- Anticipated construction completion: Spring 2019
- 1,173 feet of trail (0.2 miles)





# **PROJECT STATUS**



#### Wickersham Section: Elmont to Riverside

- Started construction in March 2019
- Anticipated completion in Spring 2019
- Estimated project cost: \$440,000



## Riverside to Oltorf

- Entered design phase in Fall 2016
  - Design phase is currently 60% complete
- Anticipated construction: Fall 2020-Spring 2022
- Estimated project cost: \$6,250,000






# DRAFT RECOMMENDATIONS



## Trail Features: Wickersham Section (Elmont to Riverside)

- 1,800 feet of trail with protected bike lane improvements
- 11 feet wide
- · Primarily uses on-street asphalt surface
