Violet Crown Trail - North

Home Depot Boulevard to MoPac

OVERVIEW

Violet Crown Trail – North is a one-mile section of the Violet Crown Trail that extends from Home Depot Boulevard to Mopac, just north of William Cannon Drive.

PROJECT PURPOSE

Violet Crown Trail – North will connect existing portions of the Violet Crown Trail, which will ultimately be a 30-mile trail system that runs from Barton Springs Pool in Austin south into Hays County.


FUNDING

- \$1.7 M from a Capital Area Metropolitan
 Planning Organization (CAMPO) grant
- \$1.2 M from the 2016 Mobility Bond
- \$550,000 from the 2012 Bond

ANTICIPATED TIMELINE

- Planning Phase: Spring 2014-Winter 2014
- **Design Phase**: Spring 2015-Winter 2019
- Anticipated Construction: Fall 2021-Fall 2022
