A guide to using your **City of Austin curbside** collection services

Austin Resource Recovery provides services designed to transform waste into resources and keep our community clean.

Trash and composting are collected every week. Recycling is collected every other week. All curbside collections happen on the same day of the week.

#### **Curbside Collection Tips**

- Place carts at the curb by 6:30 a.m. on your collection day.
- Set your carts 5 feet apart.
- Only BPI-certified compostable bags are accepted in your green composting cart.
- Do not place recycling in plastic bags.

\* Small branches and tree limbs (no longer than 5 feet or thicker than 3 inches in diameter) that do not fit in your cart with the lid closed may be bundled and set out on your collection day.

## Bring Items to Austin Resource Recovery's Recycle & Reuse Drop-Off Center

At the Recycle & Reuse Drop-Off Center, you can drop off many items to be recycled, reused or safely discarded. Here are some examples of items that can be dropped off:

Plastic bags and film

Cleaning supplies

Styrofoam

- Household hazardous waste
- Paint
- Batteries Electronics
- Tires

Many materials that are dropped off at the center are in usable condition. These items go to the ReUse Store (at the same location), where other people can pick them up, free of charge. Availability varies, but items include:
