Bright Green Future Grants are sponsored by the City of Austin's Office of Sustainability and funded by Austin Resource Recovery, and the Watershed Protection, Public Works, and Austin Transportation Departments. Grant recipients are selected by a panel of judges composed of Office of Sustainability staff, representatives from funding departments, EcoRise Youth Innovations staff, and community members who serve on the City's Environmental Board, Electric Utility Board, Food Policy Board, Water and Wastewater Commission, and Zero Waste Advisory Commission.

School-based sustainability projects may receive grant funding up to \$3,000 per project. Selected projects must also submit a Project Information Sheet and photos to the Office of Sustainability upon completion.
