Opportunity to Give Input on Proposed Street Improvements

The Austin Transportation Department (ATD) works to improve streets to make Austin travel safer. 7th Street, from Sabine Street to Navasota Street, is being evaluated for improvements to enhance the safety and mobility of everyone who uses these streets. You are receiving this notification because you live on and/or own property adjacent to 7th Street in Austin, Texas or are otherwise registered with the City as a stakeholder in the area.

Project Proposal:

ATD is proposing mobility enhancements on 7th Street to improve safety for all roadway users, improve crossings for people walking and improve comfort for people traveling by bicycle.

Proposed improvements include:

- **7th Street** (IH 35 to Navasota) – The intersections with San Marcos Street and Waller Street are proposed to become signalized and include new pedestrian crossings. Improved pedestrian crossings are also proposed at the intersections with Lydia and Attayac Streets. To improve traffic flow on 7th Street, the existing typical cross-section east of Lydia is proposed to be extended west to I-35. This includes the addition of a continuous left turn lane and bicycle lanes. To enhance safety and allow for this continuity, on-street parking for this segment of 7th Street would be removed, as shown in Figure 1. The typical cross-section proposed for this section is shown in Figure 3.
- **7th Street** (Sabine Street to IH 35) is proposed to improve safety and connectivity of the bicycle network with the addition of an eastbound bicycle lane. This will result in the removal of three paid parking spaces.

How to Provide Input

ATD is seeking feedback from people who use this street. City staff are hosting an event to explain the project, listen, and address any concerns.

Figure 1 – 7th Street Project Area and Planned Improvements

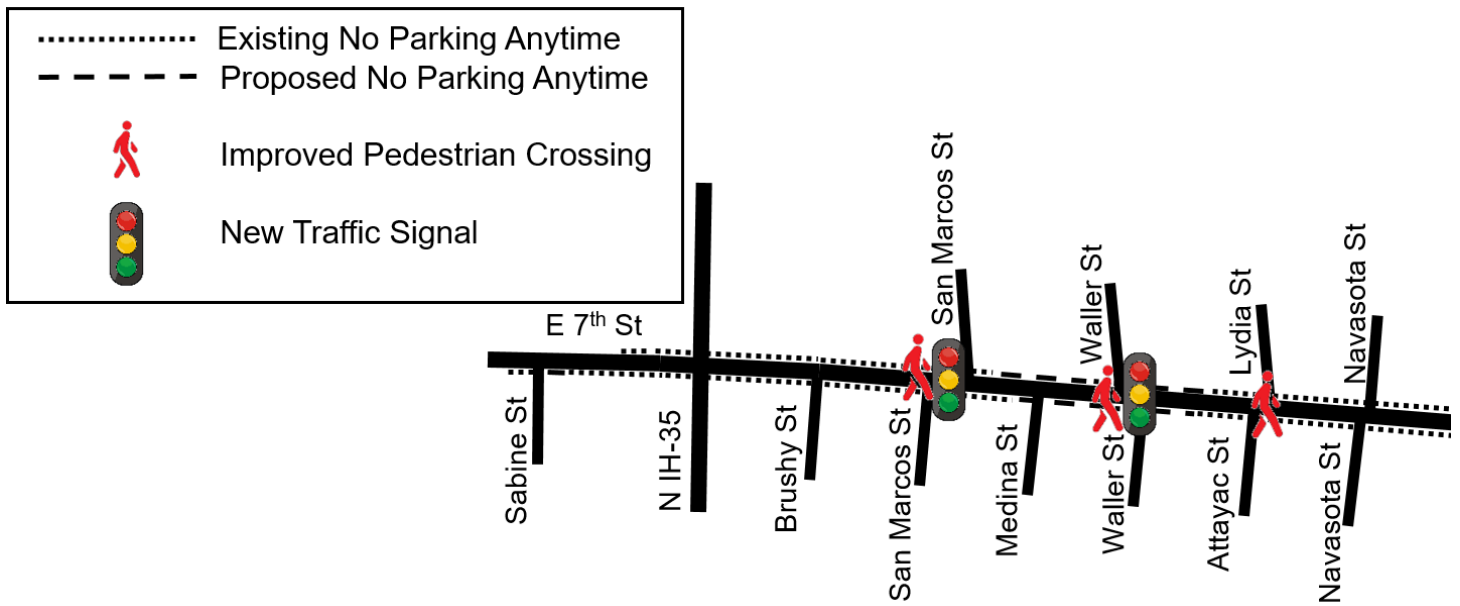
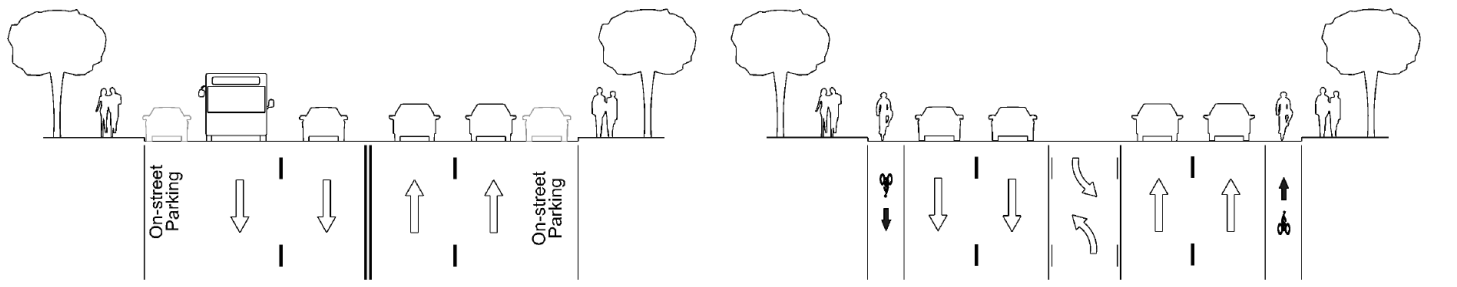


Figure 2 – Typical Existing Cross Section for 7th Street – I-35 to Lydia Street
