## Food Scraps

Cooked or raw meat, poultry and seafood (including bones), cheese, dairy products, fruits, vegetables, grains, pasta, eggshells, bread, coffee grounds, tea bags, baked goods, nuts, jelly, tea leaves, candy, snack foods, leftovers and spoiled food

## Food-Soiled Paper

Paper bags, napkins, towels, plates, cups, containers and take out-boxes, pizza boxes, coffee filters, microwavable popcorn bags, newspaper, milk cartons, tissues

# Yard Trimmings

Grass clippings, small branches, small tree limbs (no longer than 5 feet and no thicker than 3 inches in diameter), tree roots, flowers, leaves, plants, straw, soil

#### Other

Cotton balls, dryer lint, Popsicle sticks, sawdust (in paper bags), shredded paper (in paper bags), toothpicks, wooden chopsticks

## Paper

Glossy paper, office paper, junk mail, wrapping paper, envelopes, catalogs, greeting cards, "Post-it" Notes

#### Boxboard & Cardboard

Cereal boxes, shoe boxes, gift boxes, soda/ beverage containers, food packaging containers such as boxes of macaroni and cheese, rice, microwave meals, paper towel rolls

#### Aluminum & Metals

Soda cans, aluminum containers, aluminum baking tins, food cans and their caps or lids, aluminum trays, pie plates, aluminum foil (clean, balled)

#### Glass

Jars and bottles

#### Plastic Containers

Hard plastic containers with labels #1 - 7 (e.g., yogurt and margarine tubs, detergent bottles, water bottles, spray bottles, milk jugs)
