

Smoke Testing FAQ 2015

Will my Austin Water services be interrupted?

No, there is no disruption of your normal Austin Water services.

I have pets. Will the smoke bother them?

The smoke used is non-toxic and harmless to pets and humans; however there is always the possibility that if there is a defect in your private plumbing harmful sewer gases could enter your home. Also, it is possible your pet could become frightened should smoke be present. We recommend either relocating or monitoring your pet during the smoke testing and not breathing in the smoke.

There are elderly in the house with medical equipment. Will it harm them?

The smoke used is non-toxic and harmless; however there is always the possibility that if there is a defect in your private plumbing harmful sewer gases could enter your home. We recommend that you do not leave the elderly or disabled unattended during the testing process, especially if they have limited mobility or are using any special medical equipment.

Will the smoke leave an odor in my house?

No, the smoke is odorless and non-staining.

Is the smoke poisonous?

The smoke used is non-toxic and harmless; however there is always the possibility that if there is a defect in your private plumbing harmful sewer gases could enter your home.
