NOTE:

- 1. Standard Marking: At least every two feet along its length, the polyethylene film shall be marked with the following information: Manufacturer's name or trademark, year of manufacture, ANSI/AWWA/C105/A21.5, minimum film thickness (0.008" or 8 mils is required) and material type (LLDPE is required), applicable range of nominal pipe diameter sizes, Warning Corrosion Protection Repair any damage.
- 2. Special marking: In addition to the above information, the marking on polyethylene encasement used for reclaimed water shall contain "Reclaimed Water," and encasement used for wastewater shall contain "Wastewater."
- 3. Any missing information is cause for rejection of the material.
