



Annexation Request Form

Section 25-4-195 of the Austin City Code requires landowners to request annexation as a condition of extending municipal water and wastewater service to property located outside of the City's full purpose jurisdiction. Following approval of the Service Extension Request (SER), the City may record the owner's annexation request in the county deed records.

The undersigned requests full purpose annexation of the subject tract into the City of Austin's full purpose jurisdiction in accordance with Chapter 43 of the Texas Local Government Code.

Requesting annexation does not change the City's obligation to provide municipal services in accordance with Chapter 43 of the Texas Local Government Code.
