



ONION CREEK HIKE



DRIVING DIRECTIONS: The gate address is 6555 FM 967. From Austin, head south on IH35. Take exit 225/Onion Creek Pkwy and turn right about ½ mile down onto FM 1626. Continue on 1626 through lights at Manchaca Rd. & Brodie Lane. At the intersection with FM 967, turn right and continue driving west on FM 967 to the entrance gate, which is 3.4 miles ahead on the left immediately past a pair of mailboxes.
