Please help keep your creek clean:

WASTE:

- Pick up pet waste (Scoop the Poop)
- Throw away trash
- Do not put leaves, cut grass and other yard waste in or near storm drains

YARD CARE:

- Use fertilizers sparingly
- Use chemicals as a last resort

VEHICLES:

- Dispose of used motor oil and other car fluids at your local service station or the Household Hazardous Waste Facility (974-4343)
- Fix vehicle leaks
- Use a car wash, or wash your vehicle where the soap and water flow into the grass, not the street

Sweep surface area

Remove paper from adhesive

Place adhesive on surface
(marker or ground)

Place marker
