AeroMexico announces Austin-Mexico City nonstop

AeroMexico has announced new nonstop flights between Austin, Texas and Mexico City, Mexico. The new service is scheduled to start November 17, 2016.

“AeroMexico’s new Austin-Mexico City service will build a bridge to opportunities in Mexico,” said Mayor Steve Adler. “This new direct flight links our two capitals and brings Mexico City’s ancient pyramids that much closer to our statues of Willie Nelson and Stevie Ray Vaughan. Welcome, AeroMexico.”

From Austin, the flights will depart Tuesdays, Thursdays, Saturdays, and Sundays at 1:09 p.m., arriving in Mexico City at 3:33 p.m. Return flights from Mexico City will depart at 9:30 a.m., on the same days, arriving in Austin at 11:53 a.m.

From Mexico City, convenient connections to 45 destinations in Mexico are available on AeroMexico. From the Mexico City hub, AeroMexico offers easy connections for



Palacio de Bellas Artes (Palace of Fine Arts), built in the early 1900s, is a Mexico City landmark and tourist destination. The white-marble palace hosts theatrical performances, is home to the National Museum of Architecture, and features numerous art galleries, murals, and sculptures.

Austin travelers to Latin America, including Cancun (CUN); Oaxaca, Mexico (OAX); Veracruz, Mexico (VER); Lima, Peru (LIM); and Bogota, Columbia (BOG).

“The new Austin – Mexico City nonstop flight is a step forward to the strengthening of the relationship between two capital cities that will not only bring both of our people closer than ever, but also expand our economic and trade potential,” said the Consul General of Mexico in Austin, Carlos González Gutiérrez.

Sneak Peek: Retro renovation plans for South Terminal

LoneStar Airport Holdings, LLC, hosted a “Sneak Preview” on July 13 to showcase plans to transform the South Terminal into a unique traveling experience at Austin-Bergstrom International Airport.

The drawings released by LoneStar Airport Holdings show a stylish retro interior design with an exterior design that features a series of white canopies. The entire project renovates the 30,000 square-foot South Terminal facility. LoneStar Airport Holdings, LLC, a subsidiary company of Oaktree Capital Group, is overseeing the renovation project, budgeted at \$12 million.

“Ground-level aircraft boarding invokes the golden age of mid-century air travel – when passengers walked across the tarmac to board their flights,” said Jeff Pearse, CEO of LoneStar Airport Holdings, LLC, “that golden age became the basis for our interior design. Mid-century cues in furniture and finishes – utilizing textures and colors native to the Texas Hill Country will provide Austin travelers an airport experience as unique as our city!”

LoneStar states that the facility will have eight check in counters, a TSA checkpoint, check-baggage screening, a hold room and a baggage claim area along with other airport amenities. The South Terminal is expected to have three

aircraft parking gates and the public-private developed project between the City of Austin, Department of Aviation and LoneStar Airport Holdings, LLC is estimated to be completed in 2017.

The South Terminal has a separate entrance on the south side of the airport and is not accessible from inside the Barbara Jordan Terminal or from SH 71. The building dates back to the original Bergstrom Air Force Base. Now undergoing renovations, the South Terminal is designed for use by ultra-low-cost carriers.

The busy summer travel season continues at Austin-Bergstrom International Airport as 1,135,796 passengers flew Austin in June 2016, up four percent. Year-to-date passenger traffic is up eight percent in 2016.

Volaris launches new nonstop from Austin to Guadalajara, Mexico



Volaris launched its new nonstop flights between Austin-Bergstrom International Airport (AUS) and Miguel Hidalgo y Costilla Guadalajara International Airport (GDL) on Sunday, August 7, 2016. The inaugural arriving flight received a water cannon salute. Departing passengers at the gate enjoyed cake, a ribbon cutting ceremony, and live musical performances by the Gabriel Santiago Project.

“Day after day we strive to extend Volaris’ connectivity and services to benefit our customers and maintain our position as the Mexican airline with the widest presence

in the US,” said Holger Blankenstein, Chief Commercial Officer of Volaris. “The new Austin-Guadalajara route improves our presence in the Texas market adding to San Antonio, Houston, and Dallas.”

Flights operate on Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Sundays on a 179-seat, A-320 aircraft. Flights depart at 1:20 p.m. from Austin, arriving in Guadalajara at 3:28 p.m. Return flights depart GDL at 9:33 a.m., arriving at AUS at 11:50 a.m.

Condor extends Austin-Frankfurt nonstop schedule in 2017

Condor Airlines has announced it is extending service in 2017 in Texas with its nonstop route between Austin-Bergstrom International Airport (AUS) and Frankfurt International Airport (FRA). Seasonal service in 2017 will be extended to May through October. Inaugural AUS-FRA service launched in 2016 on June 27 and continued through September 1.

“The booking outlook is so promising that we’ve already made the flights available for next summer and extended the season so there are even more opportunities for you to fly to

Europe,” said Wilken Bellmann, Condor’s Head of Network Development Long-Haul.

Flights operate on Condor’s B767-300ER, which has 259 seats with 18 business, 35 premium, and 206 economy class seats.

“The addition of Austin, as our 14th destination in the United States, shows clearly how important the U.S. market is for Condor. The demand for passengers to travel to Germany or beyond from North America is as high as ever before,” said Jens Boyd, Condor’s Director Long Haul & Revenue Management.


Retail Center with restaurants, convenience store breaks ground

A ground breaking ceremony for a new Retail Center was held on August 5, 2016 at Austin-Bergstrom International Airport. Construction on the 10,000 sq. ft. retail/restaurant center and 4,500 sq. ft. convenience store, with 10 gas pumps, is expected to be completed in summer 2017. The development plans to include a playground, public restrooms, electric car recharge stations, and additional parking for those waiting to pick up passengers.

The Retail Center will be in close proximity to the Barbara Jordan Terminal and adjacent to the Hyatt Place, currently under construction. The development is situated along Presidential Boulevard and will be highly visible and very convenient for airport users and nearby residents.

The Retail Center is a public/private development with the City of Austin Department of Aviation and is being developed and managed by ABIA Retail, LLC on leased airport land.
