## Frontier adds 14 nonstops to double AUS routes to 30 cities

Low-cost carrier Frontier Airlines announced in February that it is continuing a commitment to Austin-Bergstrom International Airport (AUS) passengers by increasing the number of flight options and nearly doubling the number of nonstop destinations served to 30 cities.

Starting in April 2018, seven of the 14 new cities announced by Frontier are new nonstop destinations not serviced before from Austin. They include Buffalo, N.Y. (BUF); Charleston, S.C. (CHS); Jacksonville, Fla. (JAX); Milwaukee (MKE); Omaha, Neb. (OMA); Providence, R.I. (PVD) and Reno, Nev. (RNO). Frontier also added nonstop flights to Albuquerque, N.M., Detroit, Indianapolis, Minneapolis-St. Paul, Portland, Ore., Seattle, and Tampa, Fla.

“By nearly doubling their service again this year, Frontier’s robust growth adds to the economic vitality of Austin and central Texas,” said Jim Smith, Executive Director, Austin-Bergstrom International Airport.

In 2017, Frontier was Austin’s sixth busiest carrier, transporting 480,801 travelers through Austin-Bergstrom International Airport, up 52.5 percent from 2016.

## Allegiant launches Austin to Columbus (LCK) nonstop

Allegiant Air launched new nonstop service between Austin-Bergstrom International Airport and Rickenbacker International Airport in Columbus, Ohio (LCK).

The inaugural flight ceremony, held at the South Terminal on Feb. 16, 2018, included cake, a ribbon cutting, remarks from airport and city officials, and a live music performance by Stephen Doster.

The twice-weekly flight operates on Mondays and Fridays out of the South Terminal. Flights from Austin depart at 9:55 a.m. and arrive in Columbus at 1:28 p.m. Flights from Columbus will depart at 10:05 a.m. and arrive in Austin at 11:53 a.m.

## Year in Review - Fun facts about the airport

Last year was another record-setting year at the airport with 13.8 million passengers, up more than 11.6 percent from 2016. The airport exceeded last year's 12.4 million passengers, making 2017 the eighth consecutive year the airport has set a record for passenger traffic.

## Delta announces nonstop Austin to Cincinnati / Northern Kentucky

Delta Airlines announced new nonstop service between Austin-Bergstrom International Airport (AUS) and Cincinnati / Northern Kentucky (CVG) International Airport.

This new, year-round nonstop will begin on May 1, 2018, and operate six days per week, Sundays – Fridays. Flights depart

Cincinnati at 9:50 a.m. and arrive in Austin at 11:25 a.m.

Last year, Delta added three nonstop destinations. The addition of Cincinnati / Northern Kentucky marks the tenth nonstop destination Delta offers from the Austin airport.

## Southwest adds additional nonstop for Austin-Cancun

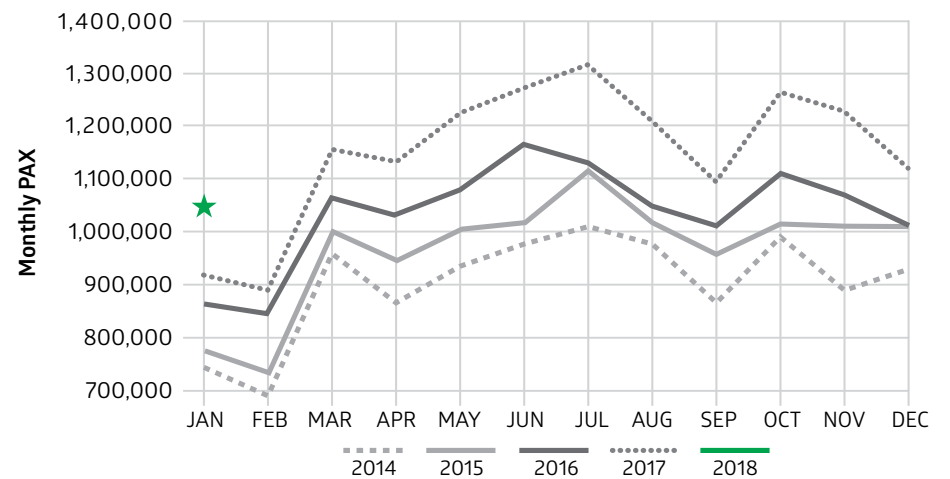
