Allegiant begins nonstop service from Austin to Indy

Allegiant Air launched a new, nonstop service between Austin-Bergstrom International Airport (AUS) and Indianapolis International Airport (IND) on May 19, 2017.

Inaugural flight ceremonies were held in the South Terminal, located at 10000 Logistics Lane, and included a ribbon cutting, cake, and live music.

“We’re excited to begin these affordable, nonstop flights from Indy to authentic Austin,” said Lukas Johnson, Allegiant senior vice president of commercial. “We know travelers will take advantage of this year-round service to enjoy convenient getaways to the Live Music Capital of the World.”

The new year round flight will operate twice weekly out of the South Terminal, Allegiant Air’s new home at the Austin airport. Allegiant flights to Indianapolis depart from Austin on Fridays and Mondays at 9:30 a.m. and arrive in Indianapolis



at 12:50 p.m. Flights depart Indianapolis on Mondays and Fridays at 10:50 a.m. and arrive in Austin at 12:25 p.m.

“Now the race fans in Indy can easily come to our Grand Prix at the Circuit of America or see a concert there and enjoy the Live Music Capital of the World,” said Jim Smith, executive director of Austin-Bergstrom International Airport. “We welcome Allegiant’s growth at Austin’s airport.”

Construction begins on new 6,000 space parking garage

A new six level parking garage is under construction at Austin-Bergstrom International Airport to provide 6,000 covered parking spaces within walking distance of the Barbara Jordan Terminal. It will be located at the site that previously was Lot A that is now closed for the construction of the parking garage.

The project, funded at \$250 million, includes improvements in addition to the garage. The overall project includes:

- The new, 6,000 space parking garage
- New entry plazas to the parking lots, garages and to the Rental Car Facility
- Enlarging and upgrading the north exit plaza to meet demands of expanded parking operations.
- Upgrades to signs along Presidential Blvd.
- Aviation administrative building

The project was approved by the Austin City Council on March 23, 2017. City Council approved PGAL as the



project architect. Austin Commercial was approved as the contractor. The garage is scheduled to be completed in 2018 and the administrative building in 2019. The former Lot A location accommodated 1,021 parking spaces. The new garage with 6,000 spaces significantly increases parking capacity close to the Barbara Jordan Terminal. Currently, ABIA Parking offers 4,088 garage

parking spaces with 7,268 economy spaces in surface open lots B-G. When needed 850 spaces are available for overflow at the economy rate that opens when all lots are full.

Alaska adds San Jose, San Diego nonstop

Alaska Airlines announced two new, daily nonstop services from Austin-Bergstrom International Airport (AUS) to Norman Y. Mineta San Jose International Airport (SJC) and to San Diego International Airport (SAN). Alaska's AUS-SJC daily service will launch on Aug. 27 and AUS-SAN daily will launch on Aug. 28, 2017.

Alaska's year round, daily nonstop flights between Austin, Texas and San Jose, California will depart Austin at 3 p.m. and arrive in San Jose at 4:50 p.m.

Flights depart San Jose at 8:45 a.m. and arrive in Austin at 2:02 p.m.

Daily nonstop flights between Austin, Texas and San Diego, California will depart Austin at 8:30 a.m. and arrive in San Diego at 9:30 a.m. Flights depart San Diego at 6:55 p.m. and arrive in Austin at 11:35 p.m. Both flights will be operate using SkyWest Airlines E175 jets.

Second busiest month recorded in March

Austin-Bergstrom International Airport continues to experience robust growth as March 2017 went down as the second busiest month in airport history with 1,156,928 passengers. The current monthly passenger records stands at 1,165,811, set in July 2015. Overall total passenger traffic for January – April 2017 was 4,087,824, up 7 percent compared to the same time in 2016. April 2017 came in as the fifth busiest month in airport history with 1,124,625 passengers.

Delta starts Seattle, Boston nonstop

Delta Air Lines launched its new, daily nonstop service between Austin-Bergstrom International Airport (AUS) and the carrier's Pacific Northwest hub, Seattle-Tacoma International Airport (SEA) on June 12, 2017. Delta's AUS-SEA departs Austin daily at 7 a.m. and arrive in Seattle at 9 a.m. Flights depart Seattle at 5 p.m. and arrive in Austin at 11 p.m.

Delta also announced year round nonstop service between Austin and Boston Logan International Airport (BOS), starting on Sept. 10. Delta's new nonstop AUS-BOS will operate six days per week. Flights depart Austin at 6:30 a.m. and arrive in Boston at 12:20 p.m. The BOS-AUS flights depart Boston at 7:30 p.m. and arrive in Austin at 11:10 p.m.

Both flights will operate using Airbus A319 aircraft and includes first class seating.

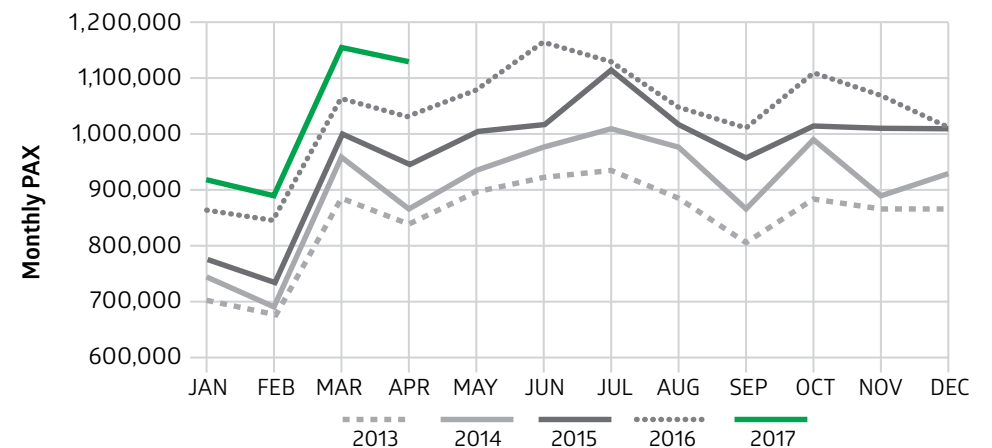
Sun Country offers new Austin to Minneapolis seasonal service

Sun Country Airlines announced new, seasonal, nonstop service between Austin-Bergstrom International Airport (AUS) and Minneapolis – St. Paul International Airport (MSP) beginning Aug. 31, 2017. The service will operate from the South Terminal on a Boeing 737-800 aircraft with first class seating.
