Subchapter S, Safety Practices Division 4, First-Aid Kits March 2023</p> <p>a) Each first-aid kit must contain the following supplies:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) A guide to first aid and emergency care [Medium]; 2) Adhesive tape [Medium]; 3) Antiseptic solution or wipes [Medium]; 4) Adhesive bandages [Medium]; 5) Scissors [Medium]; 6) Sterile gauze pads [Medium]; 7) Thermometer, preferably non-glass [Medium]; 8) Tweezers [Medium]; and 9) Waterproof, disposable gloves. [Medium] <p>b) The first-aid supplies must not have expired. [Medium]</p> </div>	<p><u>Emergency Binder</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Copy of Emergency Phone Numbers ○ Copies of emergency procedures and plans (Severe weather, fire, lockdown, etc.) with updated COVID-19 prevention measures ○ Copy of facility floor plan with marked evacuation routes ○ Printed directions to safe evacuation site ○ Up to date medication list and instructions ○ Emergency Contact information for staff and students (include pick up list for each child in case of loss of power) <p><u>Food and Water</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Equivalent of at least two 16-ounce bottles of water for each child and an appropriate amount for staff in your program per day (Try to have at least a one-day supply on hand in the event of a boil water notice or other emergency situation that impacts the water supply.) ○ Formula for infants ○ Snacks
