Austin, Texas, March 8, 1940.

Mayor Miller moved that the City Attorney be instructed to prepare an amendment to the Boat Ordinance, amending the second grammatical paragraph of Section 6 of said ordinance to hereafter read as follows:

- (1) For every boat hired or rented without outboard, or other motor - \$1 prorated as follows: for the first quarter, 75¢; for the second quarter, 50¢; and for the third quarter, 25¢.
- (2) For every boat hired or rented with outboard, or other motor - \$2
- (3) For every boat used to carry passengers for hire on Lake Austin - \$3

The motion was seconded by Councilman Wolf, and the same prevailed by the following vote: Ayes, Councilmen Alford, Gillis, Mayor Miller, and Councilman Wolf; nays, none; Councilman Bartholomew absent.

Mayor Miller moved that no permits be granted to seaplanes or aquaplanes on Lake Austin until it is clearly shown to the City Council and the Navigation Board that the same are safe.
