REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL:

Austin, Texas, May 20, 1943

The City Council convened in Regular Session at the regular meeting place in the Council Chamber at the Municipal Building, on Thursday, May 20, 1943, at 10:30 A. M., with Mayor Tom Miller presiding. Roll call showed the following members present: Councilmen Alford, Bartholomew, Gillie, and Mayor Miller; absent, Councilman Wolf.

There were present also: Walter H. Seeholm, Acting City Manager; and J. E. Matheral, City Engineer.

The Minutes of the Regular Meeting of May 13, 1943, were read, and upon motion of Councilman Alford, were adopted as read by the following vote: "ayes," Councilmen Alford, Bartholomew, Gillie, and Mayor Miller; "nays," none; Councilman Wolf absent.

A committee of Negroes representing the Colored Ministers Alliance, the Executive Committee of the Negro Recreation War Council, the Negro Civic Clubs, and the Negro Lawyers, with Dr. E. H. Givens as spokesman, presented a request to the Council for more adequate facilities for the entertainment of visiting Negro soldiers. Following the discussion, the matter was taken under advisement, pending an inspection on the ground of a proposed site for a recreation center, known as the Cotton Club on

East 11th Street.

Buster Cheriwo petitioned the Council for remission of a fine imposed against him in the Corporation Court. The matter was taken under advisement.

The application of R. G. Mallory for a wine and beer permit for Mallory's, 401 West 6th Street, recommended for approval by the Acting City Manager, et al., was submitted. Councilmen Alford moved that the application be approved. The motion carried by the following vote: "ayes," Councilmen Alford, Bartholomew, Gillis, and Mayor Miller; "nays," none; Councilman Wolf absent.

Councilman Gillis offered the following resolution:

(RESOLUTION)

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

THAT Walter E. Seaholm, the Acting City Manager, be, and he is hereby, authorized and directed to execute for and in behalf of the City of Austin a deed to B. H. Childress, conveying Lot No. 7, Block "E", J. E. Bouldin Addition, in the City of Austin, for a total consideration of \$119.65.

Upon motion of Councilman Gillis, the foregoing resolution was adopted by the following vote: "ayes," Councilmen Alford, Bartholomew, Gillis, and Mayor Miller; "nays," none; Councilman Wolf absent.

Upon motion, seconded and carried, the meeting was then recessed at 11:50 A. M., subject to call of the Mayor.
