

City Council Room, Oct. 7th 1872

The City Council met at its regular monthly Meeting.

Present: His Honor, Col. J. W. Glenn, Mayor in the Chair.

City Sexton Reports for the Months of July August & September 1872 were presented, read, received and adopted.

A Petition from a Number of Citizens of the City of Austin, asking to have the Barber Shops, prevented from keeping open doors and doing business after the hours of 10 A. M. on Sundays. The Petition was read and referred to a Committee.

Messrs. Brueggerhoff & Willis appointed by the Mayor, as said Committee.

Petition of H. J. Dutton was read and referred to City Attorney for consideration and decision.

Bill Petition of O. F. Girk accompanied with his for assessment was read and referred to the City Attorney for examination and if found correct to be put in the hand of the Finance Committee to be audited for payment.

Alderman J. H. Robinson offered the following Resolution:
Be it resolved by the City Council

of the City of Austin,
That a Committee of two Alderman
be appointed by his Honor the Mayor, to
call upon the Governor of the State to con-
sult with him in reference to the Laws go-
verning City Election of this State.

The Resolution was adopted by an unani-
mous vote.

nance Committee.

Alderman W. Prueggerhoff offered the follow-

That the Bill for Rent of Hook & Ladder
Co. A. S. is hereby ordered paid if the Com-
mittee on Fire Department find the same
to be correct and certified by the Chief of
Fire Department.

The Resolution was passed by an un-
animous Vote.

Petition of W. S. Baker was presented, as-
king the privilege to enlarge a Wooden
Building of his.

Referred to the Fire Committee.

Petition from the Police of the City of
Austin, asking for an increase of salary,
was read and referred to Committee on
Police.

Alderman Robinson offered the following Reso-
lution:

Be it resolved by the City Council of
the City of Austin, That

That Policeman J. M. Hartson and City-Marshal W. E. Evans be paid \$250⁰⁰ as the remainder due, as offered by the Mayor of the City of Austin for the apprehension of the Murderer of James Philpot.
